Anthony Joshua has invested in a luxury, state-of-the-art boutique boxing gym.

The heavyweight world champion has backed the new members-only facility BXR which will open in London in January.

Joshua said: "BXR is a passion project for me. I want people to train like I train.

"We have pulled together the best coaches, medical teams and equipment in the business and brought the ring to Chiltern Street, offering state of the art training facilities for anyone who wants to join."

The gym will feature top-of-the-range equipment as well as a sound system straight from the superclubs in Ibiza.

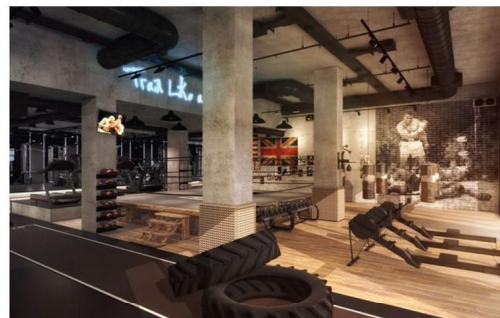
Joshua added: "I spend the majority of my life in the gym so I know what is required to make a truly great one. I was absolutely blown away by the passion and enthusiasm of the BXR team to create something that does not exist in London currently.

"This is a truly unique offering and what is more it is in the heart of London. I can't wait to kick off my London sessions at BXR."

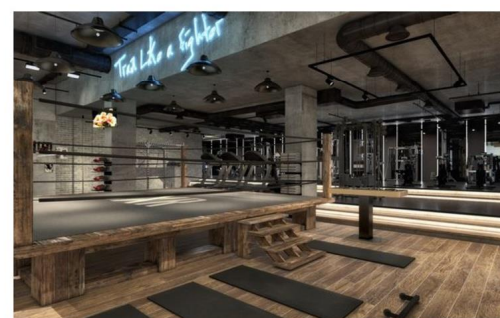
The gym will also boast an outlet of Juicery Joe and the Juice and an in-house clinic, consisting of three treatment rooms.

Joshua won his world title with a second-round KO of Charles Martin earlier this year and made his first defence against Dominic Breazeale.

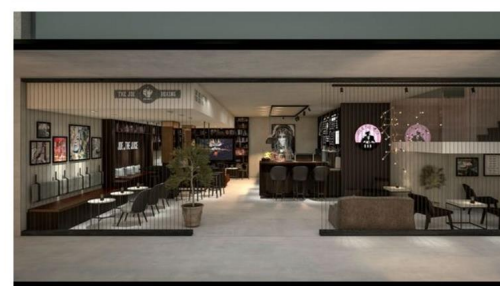
The 2012 Olympic gold medalist will return to the ring on December 10 against Eric Molina in Manchester.
