GREAT SCOTLAND YARD HOTEL BECOMES REALITY

The ex-police HQ will see a complete interior renovation, creating 150+ hotel jobs at a brand new Great Scotland Yard hotel.

Featured in the literary works of Charles Dickens and Sherlock Holmes author Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, Great Scotland Yard was the headquarters for the British police force for nearly 60 years during the Victorian era. Rebuilt in 1950 and now under the lease of home developers the Galliard Group, the historic building will be fully renovated to house a five-star, £100 million luxury hotel employing upwards of 150 people in the heart of London.



The Great Scotland Yard hotel will have a total 235 luxury rooms, a winter garden lounge, grand entrance foyer, ballroom, private dining rooms, a 120 seat conference room and restaurant and cocktail bar.

VIP suites created from an adjoining Edwardian office building will expect to fetch up to £10,000 per night when the hotel opens in Spring 2016. With a private entrance, the bedroom suite will occupy its own private floor complete with walk-in dressing rooms, day room and a spa-style main bathroom with living room, media room and other entertaining on other levels, the Great Scotland Yard hotel will become one of London's most exclusive locations.

"Our vision is to create one of London's most outstanding 5-star hotels. It really is a blue-chip building with grand architecture, a fascinating history and large dramatic interiors. The street is quiet and tranquil yet on the doorstep of London's most famous landmarks including Trafalgar Square, 10 Downing Street, the Mall and Buckingham Palace." – **Stephen Conway, chief exec. of Galliard Group**



Situated in a perfect location between Belgravia and Pimlico, a two minute walk from the River Thames, St. James' Park and Buckingham Palace and with Westminster on the doorstep, Great Scotland Yard could well become one of the most sought-after residences in the capital. A far cry from its origins as a municipal building for the Army and headquarters of the police forces.
